## **THE COURSE**

Trying to navigate your way through the college maze? This course is designed to help you sort through your personal needs as you begin to look for a college that is your "best fit." You will walk away from this course with:

Minimum enrollment for the course is 10 students with a maximum of 28. The course is Monday through Friday and held in a classroom in the Upper School (location t.b.a.).
